

DIRECTOR'S NOTES



"Hope is the pillar that holds up the world. Hope is the dream of a waking man."

- Pliny the Elder, Roman Philosopher, circa 79 AD

On September 17 2011, a swarm of protestors invaded Zuccotti Park in the New York City financial district. The Occupy Wall Street protestors raised issues surrounding social and economic inequality, and the overbearing of business executives on government as evidenced by

recent bail outs of large corporations. While the protest was eventually forcibly displaced by police, it turned out that both the FBI and Department of Homeland Security were using counter terrorism agents and authorities to investigate protestors. Thus the ripples caused by this movement and its slogan are still being felt to this day.

"We ARF the 99%"

- Occupy Wall Street Slogan.

In developing the concept for this production of Jesus Christ Superstar, I was drawn to Judas' lyric during the song "Superstar": "If you'd come today you would have reached the whole nation". We have used the frame of the Occupy Wall Street movement to tell the story of Jesus, not only to make the story relatable to modern audiences, but to show in which ways the lessons from the story of Jesus have been forgotten. Likewise by using the story of Jesus, we aim to bring to life the struggles of a group of people who stand for something more than they can comprehend: A "Kingdom of Heaven" or the more modern concept of an equalitarian utopia in the face of crushing opposition. In many ways, the issues brought up by the stories of Jesus and Occupy Wall Street still affect us today. We still lust and suffer the ill effects of greed, while rushing to judge each other for the material aspects of our lives such as how nice a car you have, or what you wear. Income inequality is still growing. Finally, the social understanding of what it means to be united by something other than mutual exploitation, and commoditization of the natural world, each other and ourselves. We should reflect on this, and the notion that those who do not learn from the past are doomed to repeat it.

BRYAN SMITH (KEYBOARD)


This is Bryan's 7th show with FRC. He does stuff.
